Day 4 Monday October 25 Sharjah City Tour

It was the most important port on the lower Arabian Gulf from the time of the early trading with the East into the first half of the 19th century. Alongside fishing and trading, the lion's share of the city's wealth rested on its pearling industry, which lasted into the late 1940's. The first international airport on this coast was also established in Sharjah in 1932, predating the formation of the Federation of the UAE by nearly four decades.

now houses more than 5,000 exquisite artifacts from all over the Islamic world, and hosts regular exhibitions and internationally renowned displays of Islamic masterpieces.

- Al Naboodah House, a restored pearl merchant's house and museum.
- The Central Blue Souq, open since 1979, is the most famous souq in Sharjah. Discover an extraordinary collection of handicrafts, brilliant in color and magnetic in appeal. Dive into a maze of more than 600 exciting and intriguing shops and uncover unusual treasures and traditional gift items, handmade goods and regional imports.
- King Faisal Mosque, the first mosque in Sharjah to open its doors to the non-Muslim community and visitors to Sharjah so that they can learn about Islam and the United Arab Emirates culture.

Enjoy lunch at Zahr El-Laymoun and this evening when you return to Dubai you will sail under the moon lit sky on a Dhow Dinner Cruise in the Marina.

Day 5 Tuesday, October 26 Dubai Off to the Camel Races!

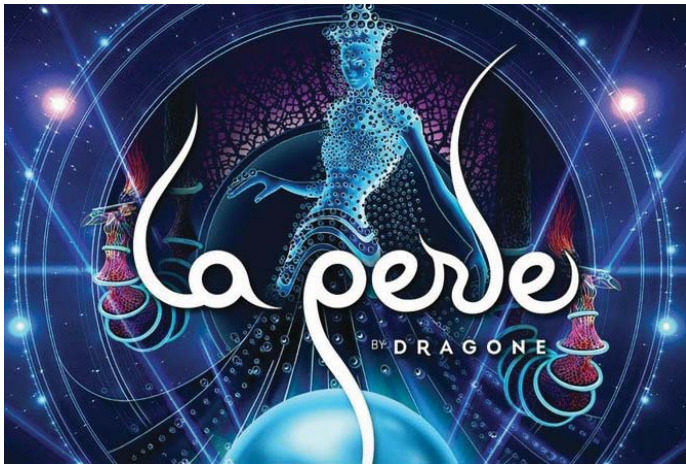

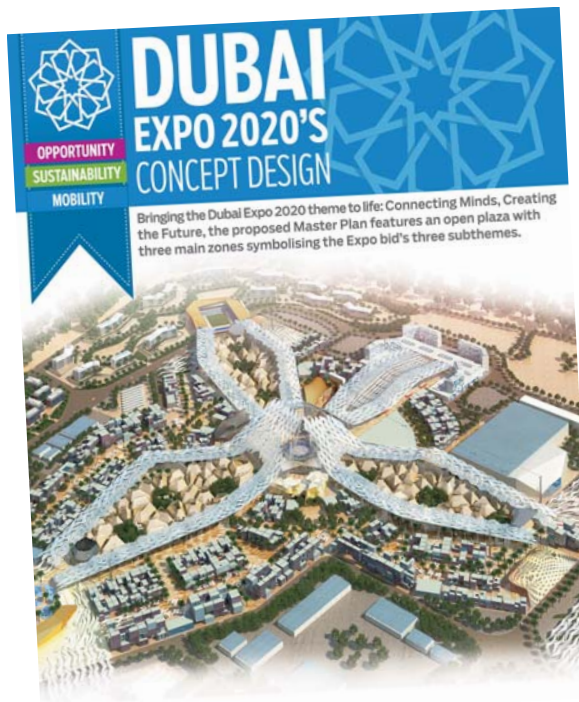
Day 9 Saturday October 30 ~ Dubai Day at Leisure

Due to the huge demand for providing their experience to other avian species, they have opened the falcon hospital to become a fully-fledged specialized avian hospital for all kinds of birds and poultry species in 2006.

Culture & Heritage

The visitors of **Dubai Museum & "Al Fahidi Fort"** have an opportunity to get rich, full and integral knowledge of the very old history of Dubai that interacted with different people and civilizations across history. Visitors will get acquainted with the different environments of urban and rural lives in Dubai, whether they are marine, coastal, desert, mountain or agricultural life. Rare authentic monuments, original samples, drawings and diagrams, audio and video media are scattered all over the wings of the museum.



The UAE's latest cultural landmark, **Dubai Frame** is an iconic structure that 'frames' impressive views of Old and New Dubai, while serving as a metaphorical bridge connecting the emirate's rich past with its magnificent present. Offering spectacular panoramic views across the city, Dubai Frame celebrates the story of Dubai from its early establishment to its ambitious plans for future development.

Al Shindagha Museum is a world-class heritage museum that connects Emiratis, residents and visitors to the rich heritage of the UAE, embracing traditional values and revealing powerful continuities between past and contemporary Emirati identity. The museum collects, researches, preserves and interprets Emirati cultural heritage, both tangible and intangible, through its innovative exhibitions, events and public learning programs. A cornerstone of the Dubai Historical District, it is a place where Emiratis, residents and visitors can celebrate and explore heritage & culture, and discover an interactive and participatory environment for all to enjoy.

A visit to the **Museum of the Poet Al Oqaili** presents a unique opportunity to experience the atmosphere of one of the most beautiful heritage houses in Dubai, which expresses the fine sense and taste of its owner as a poet, where the visitor enjoys the beautiful heritage, architectural designs and its elements reflected in the house. The visitor will also have the chance to view original documents and collections belonging to the poet Al Oqaili.

A dynamic 21st century museum, **Etihad Museum** is focused on inspiring its visitors with the story of the founding of the UAE. The 25,000 m² landmark is befittingly located at the very place where the UAE was founded in 1971. Through a unique visitor journey, the various pavilions house experience-driven exhibitions, interactive programs and education initiatives that explore the chronology of events that culminated in the unification of the Emirates in 1971, with a key emphasis on the period between 1968 and 1974.

The **Jumeirah Mosque** is one of the most loved architectural treasures in Dubai. Opened in 1979, Jumeirah Grand Mosque was a gift from the Late Sheikh Rashid bin Saeed Al Maktoum, the former Ruler of Dubai and father of the current Ruler of Dubai HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum. The Jumeirah Mosque visit has been a key activity under the Open Doors, Open Minds program of the Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding (SMCCU). Over the last two decades, our guests have consistently voted SMCCU as their favorite cultural activity in the United Arab Emirates!

The Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding (SMCCU) is a non-profit organization which promotes awareness of Emirati Culture, customs, traditions & religion among expatriates and foreign visitors in the United Arab Emirates, as well as aiming to remove cultural barriers.

SMCCU was founded in 1998 by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum and is based in a traditional Emirati wind tower house, located in Bur Dubai's historic Al Fahidi neighborhood. It operates under the banner of "Open Doors, Open Minds." The center arranges numerous activities, including tours of heritage sites and landmarks in Dubai, educational programs for students, cultural awareness events, lectures, Arabic classes as well as providing the experience of traditional Emirati food.



Enjoy traditional Emirati cuisine and conversation in the interactive cultural experiences hosted by our Emirati presenters located in one of Dubai's oldest communities.

Dubai's Iconic Landmarks

Take sightseeing to new heights with an entrance ticket to **Burj Khalifa's 'At the Top,'** one of the world's tallest observation decks, located on the skyscraper's 124th floor. After entering through Dubai Mall, enjoy a multi-media presentation about Dubai's history, and then zoom up to the observation deck by high-speed elevator to enjoy free time ogling the views. See Palm Jumeirah, Dubai Marina, Burj Al Arab and more; it's as if the city was built to be seen from this vantage point!

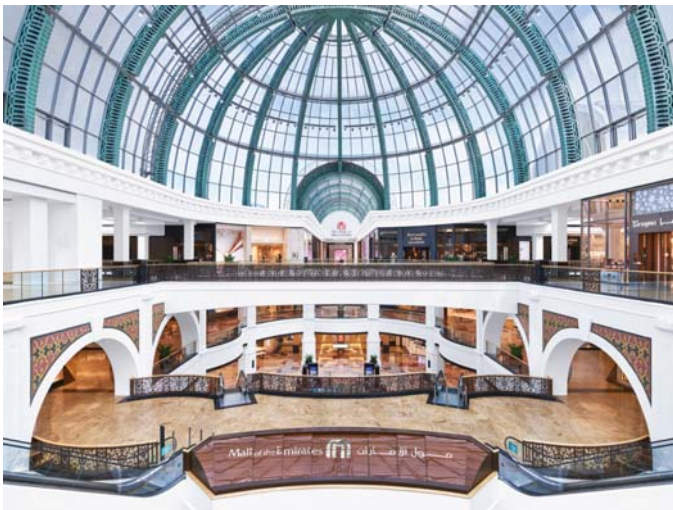
Dubai Opera, the definitive destination for performing arts in Dubai, bringing arts and music to life like never before. Located at what is billed as 'the most prestigious square kilometer in the world' in Downtown Dubai, Dubai Opera is the radiant center of culture and arts in Dubai and the shining pearl of The Opera District. Dubai Opera passionately embraces its role as the creative heart of the city, producing and hosting the finest, most authentic, and engaging performing arts experiences from Dubai and the world.



The Dubai Fountain is the world's largest dancing fountain. It sends powerful jets of water more than 500 feet (150 meters) into the air, accompanied by music and illuminated by laser projections and thousands of lights. It was designed by the creators of another world-famous fountain show, at the Bellagio hotel and casino in Las Vegas. The fountain is more than 900 feet (275 meters) long and sits on the 30-acre (12-hectare) man-made Burj Khalifa Lake in front of the Dubai Mall.

Dubai's Shopping Scene

The Dubai Mall offers an unparalleled retail mix combined with world-class dining, entertainment and leisure attractions. The Fashion Avenue, the precinct dedicated to high fashion has expanded. The Souk is an elegantly designed precinct featuring jewelry shops, accessory outlets, traditional Arab clothing and handicraft stores, among others. There is also the Dubai Aquarium & Underwater Zoo, VR Park, a unique virtual reality attraction, and other family components include KidZania®, the Reel Cinemas megaplex, and the Olympic-sized Dubai Ice Rink.
