

JOAN MIRÓ HOTEL MUSEUM

MIRÓ'S ARTISTIC SANCTUARY

The Miró Foundation Mallorca showcases the work of the renowned painter Joan Miró. This space, housed in a former textile factory, offers an intimate insight into the artist's creativity, with an extensive collection of paintings, sculptures and graphic works. In addition, its gardens and terraces provide a serene setting to explore the inspiration behind Miró's work.

THE PATH OF TOTALITY

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Earth and the Sun, blocking the Sun's light from reaching the Earth. The Moon's shadow casts a trail on Earth called the path of totality, where the Sun is completely blocked for a few minutes, making it feel like night.

Few eclipse-chasers have experienced the unparalleled thrill of seeing totality with the Sun so low down that it is a silhouetted disk distorted into an oval by atmospheric refraction.
